I wish to announce that Bishop Columba Macbeth-Green OSPPE, with the support of Father Paul Newton, has approved the appointment of Mr James Moran, as Principal of St Mary's Parish School, effective from the start of the 2023 school year.

James grew up in Sydney and he relocated to Broken Hill in 2017 where he has worked as a classroom teacher at Sacred Heart Parish School. Since January 2021 he has held the role of Literacy and Numeracy Instructional leader at Sacred Heart Parish School. This role involves him providing professional learning for the staff as well as modelling effective student learning in classrooms. From 2011 - 2015 James led the implementation of AFL sports programs in primary and secondary schools as well as training staff to deliver effective sports teaching.

James' formal qualifications include a Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice, a Master of Teaching (Primary) and a Graduate Certificate in Religious Education. This year he is enrolled in the Pathways to Leadership Course, run by the Brown Collective.

James and his fiancé are to be married in January 2023 and plan to make their home in Hay. They look forward to becoming active members of the parish, the broader community and sporting clubs in Hay.


